## Low-Fat Macaroni and Cheese Recipe

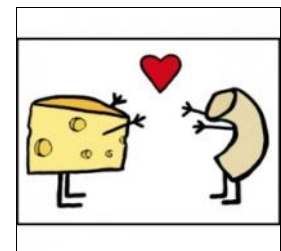

### Ingredients

3/4 cup(s) milk, fat-free evaporated  
1 cup(s) cottage cheese, low-fat  
1/2 cup(s) cheese, ricotta, low-fat  
1/2 cup(s) cheese, cheddar, low-fat  
1/2 teaspoon nutmeg, ground  
1 dash(es) salt and black pepper, to taste  
1 teaspoon cheese, Parmesan  
1 tablespoon bread crumbs, fine, dry  
1 pounds pasta, elbow macaroni, cooked



### Preparation

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Heat the milk in a saucepan over low heat. Add the cheeses until they melt, stirring constantly.
2. Stir in the nutmeg, pepper, and salt. Remove the cheese sauce from the heat. Add the cooked pasta to the cheese sauce and mix well.
3. Pour the mixture into a 2-quart casserole dish. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and bread crumbs. Bake the casserole for 15-20 minutes until bubbly and the top is browned.

## Crime Bulletin

### Larceny of Multiple A/C Units in the Hamptons Neighborhood

#### Activity Summary:

- From 12/25/11 to 12/29/11, HPD has received 11 reports regarding Larceny of A/C Units (at least 19 A/C Units total).
- The incidents have been discovered between the hours of **0030 and 1715 on each day of the current week thus far.**
- In all incidents, the suspect(s) removed the tops and fans of the units and cut out the copper coils from within. Recently, copper prices have increased significantly throughout the United States. The suspect is clearly targeting only the copper components inside the A/C units.
- There have been 2 locations in which the A/C units were tampered with but not damaged.



The blue place markers on this map indicate the larceny locations.

#### Recommendations for Citizens:

- Leave all possible outside lighting turned on throughout the nighttime hours.
- Keep a lookout for any persons walking between houses.
- Immediately call 911** to report any suspicious persons or vehicles in the neighborhood.

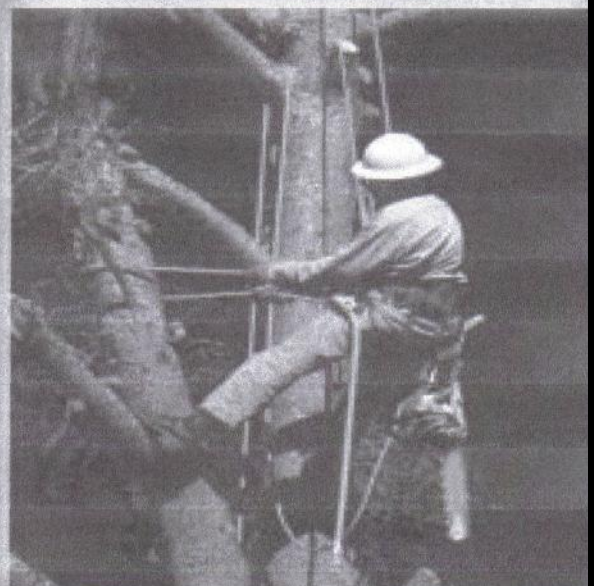

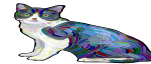

## 2012 Chinese New Year

The first day of the 2012 Chinese New Year is on **January 23, 2012** in China's time zone. This day is a new moon day, and is the first day of the **first Chinese lunar month** in the Chinese Lunar Calendar system. The exact new moon time is at 15:40 on 23-Jan-12 in China's time zone.



**The Year 2012 is the 4709th Chinese year.** The Chinese believe that the first king of China was the Yellow King (he was not the first emperor of China). The Yellow King became king in 2697 B.C., therefore China will enter the 4709th year on January 23, 2012. Also, the Chinese Year uses the cycle of 60 Stem-Branch counting systems and the Black Water Dragon is the 28th Stem-Branch in the cycle. Since  $(60 * 78) + 29 = 4709$ , therefore 2012 is the Water Dragon year, which is the 4709th Chinese Year.

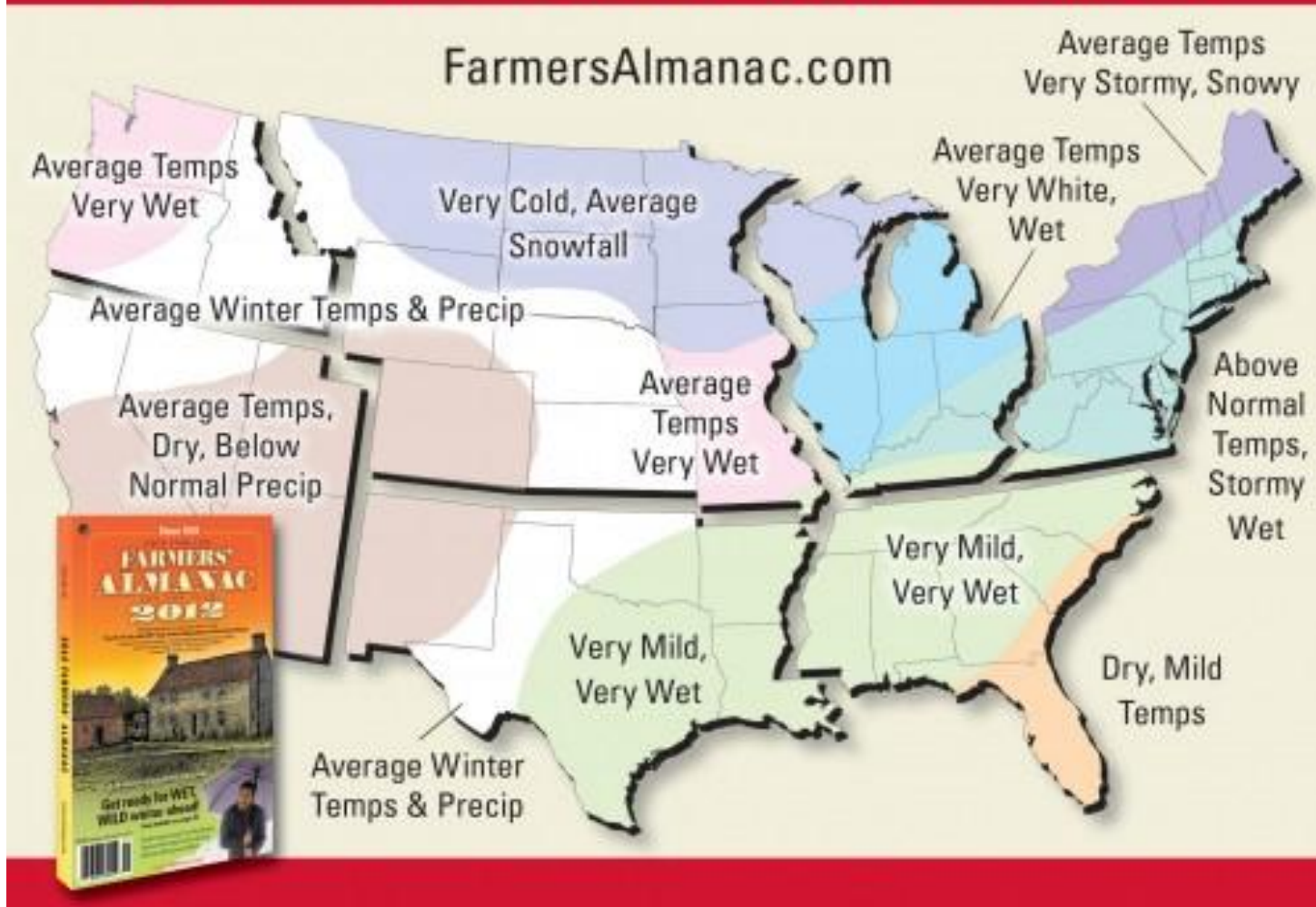
